In 1996-1999 he served as Principal Assistant to the Minister of Defense for Strategic Affairs.

In 1992-1999 he served as head of the Inter-Ministerial Steering Committee on Arms Control & Regional Security. In 1986-1999 he was Chief Israeli Representative to the Israel–US Strategic Dialogue (JPMG)

David Ivry is the Chairman of the National Council for Civil Service and a member of the Board of Governors, Technion University. He serves as an Honorary Chairman of “Atid Batuach” – a forum for leading members acting to secure a better future for our children.

He served as chairman of The Fisher Brothers Institute for Air and Space Strategic Studies in 1999-2011. In 1978-1982 he was a member of the Board of Directors, El Al Israeli Airlines and also served in 2004-2010 as a member of the Board of Directors, The Hebrew University, Jerusalem
